AGM

It's that time of year again! Our AGM will be at 10.30am on Sunday morning 24th November and all are welcome to attend. As you will be aware, only Full members are able to vote but this year there are several matters where your opinions will count. If you are a Full member and unable to attend then don't forget to use the proxy vote.

Election of Officers

Hopefully you will have seen the Election of Officers notice which has been posted in the Bar area showing who will be restanding and the vacancies for posts on the Management Committee.

These are very important roles and we need proposals to fill them by Sunday 27th October. So far, we still have vacant positions for:

Bar Manager – this could be shared with another person if you are willing to take on certain elements so, do speak to Paul the Commodore who has been Bar Manager in the past and knows what is involved

Assistant Secretary – mostly minute taking at monthly meetings with some research to assist the HonSec. A good way to find out about how the Club is run and any future roles of interest

HonSec – this role is now vacant after very many years and would suit someone who enjoys "housekeeping" – advising, managing and keeping us in check to ensure the Club is still in line with any legal matters or Government regulations and other more mundane stuff. An interesting and varied position. This role would be supported until the person taking over feels confident so, if you are interested, do speak to me.

Planning

If you have been in the Bar you will have seen the display showing the proposals for improvements/changes to four areas of the Club. The Management Committee are aware that some areas highlighted for development have not met with support or enthusiasm by some of the members spoken to and, as a result of this, the opinions of a wider range of our members is now being sought about this.

RC Mike Naish will be circulating a questionnaire about the proposals to <u>all</u> present at the AGM, both Full and Social members and the questionnaire will be anonymous. This is an ideal way for you to express your opinion about the proposals.

For those of you who haven't see the proposals which are posted in the Clubhouse, basically they cover the following: **Phases 1 – 3 Initial Works**; Works to refresh the beachside appearance of the Club, enhance the usability of existing space and provide better access both inside and out with the patio and beach.

New side entrance with wheelchair access (subject to Council granted access permission), allowing members in the Bar area vicinity to monitor people coming and going, whilst also creating a better route for those coming from the water, allowing us to consider alternative flooring for our main area.

On the north side, allowance for boundary improvements, a cycle store and coded gate access, which is safer for our children, as the existing system as little or no security, as well as improving boat store operational security. Budget to improve vessel launch and retrieval.

Phases 4 & 5 Major Works (follow on); New women's changing facility located where the sail loft is, with a better laid out multi-function room in its place. Expansion of the main Club area by extension, whilst preserving the character and aesthetic of the railway carriage on the eastern side, relocation of the Bar and ancillary facilities. Likelihood for Club closure, or sectional zonal closures for sustained periods.

Please do have a look at the 3D plans posted in the Club to get a fuller explanation and picture of what is involved – and do attend the AGM to express your opinions and complete the questionnaire.

If you have anything your wish to raise at the AGM such as a change to the Rules or as an amendment, or as a Bylaw, be sure to look up the procedures in our Rules, have it supported and submitted to the Hon Sec before **10am on 27**th **October** when the time for change expires. Please ensure your membership number and full details are included.

The agenda and full details for the AGM will be sent out by email the weekend of the 9th November so do please remember to check your Spam folders as I have been told that notifications do disappear in there. Those members who don't use the internet will have to rely on either myself walking the dog around Pagham or the postal service. I'm cheaper!

Work Party

Just a reminder that next Saturday 19th we will be having a PYC Work Party from 8am till 10.30am to sort out lots of repair and maintenance issues that have arisen over the past year that need dealing with before the winter weather closes in. Some have become quite urgent. This includes the continuation of window repairs, the replacement of the door threshold to the boat store, work on external side lights, a temporary cover over the side wall to the beer cellar and the recovery of the launching mats.
